



EXHIBIT A

Article 3 of the Articles of Incorporation, as revised:

To acquire and own rescue apparatus for use by the corporation in the protection and rescue of persons from injury or loss of life; to own and acquire land and to construct buildings for use by the corporation in connection with the housing of rescue apparatus and for the providing of a place of meeting for the members of the corporation; to sponsor or hold rescue schools; to engage in any and all types of activities not prohibited by law which shall befor the betterment of the community, county and state.

The purposes for which the corporation is organized are exclusively religious, charitable, scientific, literary and educational within the meaning of IRC 501(c)(3) or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.

Notwithstanding any other provisions of these articles, this organization shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal income tax under IRC 501(c)(3) or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.
