ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT NONPROFIT CORPORATION

Pursuant to §55A-10-05 of the General Statutes of North Carolina, the undersigned corporation hereby submits the following Articles of Amendment for the purpose of amending its Articles of Incorporation.

- 1. The name of the corporation is: ZEBULON AREA RESQUE SQUAD, INC.
- 2. The text of each amendment adopted is as follows (state below or attach):

Article 1 of the Articles of Incorporation shall be amended by deleting the provisions of the original Article and substituting therefor the following paragraph:

1. The name of the corporation is Zebulon Emergency Medical Services, Inc.

Article 3 of the Articles of Incorporation shall be amended by deleting the provisions of the original Article and of the previous Amendment and substituting therefor the following paragraph:

3. The purposes for which the corporation is organized are:

To organize, perform, promote and carry out an emergency medical service for the preservation of human life and the transportation of accident and other victims to medical centers; to administer first aid and other services for the preservation of human life and protection of property in times of emergency; to organize, promote, teach, and administer first aid and promote first aid and safety programs in the Town of Zebulon and its environs; to purchase, own, hold, rent, lease, mortgage, sell, convey, and otherwise lawfully acquire, hold, and dispose of real and personal property, or any interest therein, as may be necessary or more convenient to carry out the objects and purposes of the corporation; to purchase, lease, construct, or otherwise acquire, for cash or on terms of credit, real estate and improvements thereon, in the Town of Zebulon or elsewhere in the State of North Carolina; and generally to perform all acts and do all things which may be deemed reasonably necessary or expedient for the proper and successful achievement of the objects and purposes for which this corporation is organized.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by (a) a corporation exempt from Federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law or (b) a corporation contribution to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or under any other corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.

Article 4 Paragraph (a) of the Articles of Incorporation shall be amended by deleting the provisions of the original Article and substituting therefor the following paragraph:

(a) The corporation shall have five classes of membership: (1) Active; (2) Associate; (3) Probationary; (4) Advisory; and (5) Honorary.
