1927 Chevrolet/Boyer combination chemical truck, 40/40.


Production # 6404 or 6804.

Sold/shipped to Greensboro in December 1936.


1936 American LaFrance Type 475 pumper, 500/___ - #4611.


Delivered by March 1976. Donated by private buyer, bought from town for \$3,500.


