PRESIDENT HILDEBRAND: At this time I will ask Sherwood Brockwell to introduce to you the best friend the North Carolina firemen has.

Introduction by Mr. Brockwell of Dan C. Boney, Insurance Commissioner of North Carolina.

MR. BONEY: I know that this is a busy session this afternoon and I am just going to say that I am mighty glad to be here, and I know that we are all going to enjoy the convention.

PRESIDENT HILDEBRAND:

It is a pleasure to have Commissioner Boney with us.

We spoke of this gavel this morning and I want to take this occasion to thank the East Spencer firemen for it. Another point was brought out about the gavel that I didn't think of this morning as to the way it was made, the number of pieces, each one fitting perfectly in its own place and filling its own place, which any one knows means unity. I thank you on behalf of the association for the gavel.

It has become necessary at this time for the president to make his report of the past year. I haven't got a written report to read to you boys today because I had nothing to write about. I only have a few things to say and that is I am very, very sorry that I could not accept and fulfill the invitations I had to the eastern part of the State. As you fellows know, I am twenty miles the other side of Asheville and when we come down this far to really hold an association meeting it costs money. I appreciate the invitations of the different chiefs to attend the meetings, but on the other hand I didn't think my presence would add enough to your meetings to justify spending your money to come.

I have had a good year as far as the past year is concerned. Two thirds of the work of the organization is done by two of our old and honored members, and that is Secretary Miller and Mr. Horney, because without these two in the organization I don't know what we would do. Any information that a president wants he can get it by calling Mr. Miller. I have had full cooperation and appreciate it from the bottom of my heart. The fellows that I have visited in the western part have shown interest, and I have a few figures that I want to give you for this year's report.

As Mr. Miller told you, we had four new departments that came into the association this year. The financial report will be

given to you according to the auditor's work.

Total assets of the association in excess of \$114,000.00. So instead of going back we are going forward.

Aggregate amount of surplus this year in excess of \$8,500.00. So we are doing pretty well this year in fire departments.

(Reads report.)

The largest majority of the members are young men. I do not know how many belong to the Insurance Fund. Mr. Miller will tell us about that. That is one of the finest things in insurance that a man can carry, and it does your soul good. In one sense of the word it grieves you when you have to send a check to some one for that special purpose, but it gives you a feeling of gratitude and pleasure to be able after that fireman is gone to sign that check for a thousand dollars and send back to some loved one. Figure any line of insurance in the world and you will not find where you can get a thousand dollars as cheap as that. If you do not belong to it get blanks from your Chief and get into that insurance game, because this life is uncertain and we know death is sure.

The collection of annual dues for the association this year was \$2,552.00 against last year, which was the largest up to that time, of \$2,387.75.

So, I think I had a very helpful year in running the organization and in the financial statement of this year.

PRESIDENT JOYNER:

Most of you gentlemen know that A. B. Horney, our treasurer, has passed on and our secretary, John L. Miller, was appointed as secretary-treasurer to fill the unexpired term, and at this time we will have report from John L. Miller.

SECRETARY MILLER:

I would like to make a remark or two before I make this report. The Firemen's fraternal-insurance fund began in 1921 and began to write business in 1922. We have written forty one hundred and seven policies. More than half of these insured have either died or moved to some other point, or dropped the insurance. Today we have practically seventeen hundred paid firemen in this insurance fund. The question has come up since "Pearl Harbor" and since the boys have been going to war as to what we are going to do about the policies. The committee will not vitiate or violate any contract just so long as the insured carries out his part of the contract. We know and you know we issued these policies upon the recommendation of the Chief and Secretary of the department saying the men were in good health. The committee knew the liability attached to this paper. That liability has increased two, three or four-fold, and what we would like to have seen done was for those boys who are now volunteering or being drafted or drawn to the war, to permit their policy to stand; in the mean time take out the insurance offered by the Federal Government who can stand the liability much better than the firemen's fraternal insurance. With that in view we will not cancel any policy. All we want the boys to do is to keep their assessments up, and if the worse comes to the worse, if the boys are sacrificed on the alter of their country, it is no more than right for us to respond. That is the position the committee has taken.

I wanted you to see and know the attitude of the executive committee. No policy will be lapsed by them—we hope the boys can come back home and if they do we will be in fine shape to meet them and they will still have their policies in the Firemen's Fraternal Insurance.

that the cost of living has increased very much in the past year or so and that the officers of this association have not had any increase in salary in a number of years and that a lot of time is given to the duties of this association and that our secretary who is fully occupied with duties which require all of his time, is furnishing his office, telephone, heat and lights at no expense to the association, I recommend that the salary of the officers be increased to care for the withholding tax and be retroactive as of the withholding tax law. I further recommend that the secretary be reimbursed for the telephone rent as paid by him and that the association pay for the telephone in the future. It is not in reason for anyone to pay for something that is for the use of this association. The president would like to recommend that this association continue the North Carolina fire college and drill school as has been sponsored for years. We all realize that no fireman is qualified without training and this school has done much to improve the ability of our firemen. A grand job has been done; let's continue.

I further recommend that a legislative committee be appointed so as to handle any matter as to the welfare of our firemen and association. There are some matters that should be handled at the next legislative meeting.

As to the pension committee I think this committee should be continued and that some action be taken to safeguard our firemen when this time comes. I know that something can be worked out. Other states have laws as to the protection of our aged firemen who have given years of service so why not our state.

IN CONCLUSION:

In conclusion the president wishes to thank all of the members of the executive board, chiefs, officers and members of the North Carolina State Firemen's Association for the cooperation extended him during his office. It has been a real pleasure working with each one of you. I have had the pleasure of working closely with Chief John L. Miller, your secretary, and I don't know of a finer man more qualified who obtains the ability to serve our firemen than him.
