care in accepting favors from the public which we serve. Possibly no one else can tell us whether or not we should accept some generous gift from a grateful taxpayer. This is one of those very difficult decisions we may have to make entirely on our own. Nevertheless, in our best judgment we should be able to determine whether the gift or favor being offered is extended in appreciation for friendship or whether it is being offered to encourage a favor in return. The trouble is, so often the return favor expected of us may possibly encourage some unwise act on our part. What gift of this sort was ever worth the embarrassment, anguish and grief that results when the offering and the acceptance thereof comes to light? We can ill afford to subject our professions, our jobs and our happiness to this kind of unnecessary peril.

I hope I have not been too idealistic about the responsibilities and obligations of those of us in public service. I'm sure you share my feeling that public service is one of the truly high callings. Here is the field for the dedicated individual who is willing to put self integrity above self interest.

Public service, nevertheless, can only be as respected and as rewarding as you and I are willing to make it. The making requires loyalty to duty, regard for one's respective profession, interest in one's community, the right touch in dealing with the public, keeping the public informed and finally—handling with care those who come bearing gifts.

As men dedicating your lives to public service as firemen perhaps you could have no higher personal objective than that of being the kind of fireman who justified the dreams of the small boy I previously mentioned.
