THIS CANCELLATION OF EASEMENT made this 15th  
day of October, 1970, by and between OGDEN VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT,  
INCORPORATED, party of the first part, and HERMAN H. HALL, SR. and  
Wife, ELIZABETH HALL, parties of the second part, all of New Hanover  
County, North Carolina.

WITNESSETH:

That WHEREAS by instrument recorded June 27, 1956 in  
Book 596, at Page 68, in the New Hanover County Registry of Deeds, an

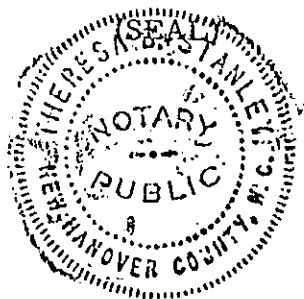
